



# *ADULTS MEDAL COMPETITION 2017*

Three Medal Competitions will be held in 2017. The 1st Medal Competition of the year will be held in March. The qualifying period will be from 1st March to 17th March. Last squad for daily qualifying is at 10.15 pm. The last squad for this competition will be at 7.00 pm on Friday, 17th March 2017. This event is open to all SRC members of age 18 & above, born in 1999 and before.

The qualifying scores will be based on best 2 attempts (total of 6 games with 3 games per attempt) during the qualifying rounds. There is no limit to the number of attempts a bowler can make. Bowlers are advised to pre-book their qualifying slots with the Bowling Counter at all times for this event during the qualifying period, as no lanes will be reserved for the event.

Bowlers can also attempt to qualify for the Medal Finals during the Monday Night Mixed League or the Saturday Social Singles Mixed League. Bowlers will have to inform the Bowling counter staff of their intention to do so before the league commences and will be charged a Trophy Fund of \$11.77 ( inclusive of GST) per attempt.

A handicap system will be used for the Medal Competition. The handicap list computed (200-average x 2/3 x 2/3) of 2016 events will be displayed on the notice board in the bowling alley.

Bowlers, from the current (2017) "National/Development Squad" including Ex- National (past 2 Years 2015 & 2016) will bowl with minus 10 (-10) for men and minus 5 (-5) for ladies and Bowlers without an established average (minimum 18 games) with the Club will not be given any handicap.

The above will apply during the qualifying rounds and the finals.

The top **8** Ladies and the Top **12** Men will bowl in the Medal Finals on 19th March 2017 for Ladies and Men .

### **Fees**

Qualifying fee per attempt is \$5.35 for Bowling Section members and \$16.05 for Non Bowling Section members. Fees for the finals will be \$16.05 for Bowling Section members and \$26.75 for Non Bowling Section members. **Bowlers will pay the above fees in addition to the games fees.**

### **Finals**

Ladies (10 games)      - Sunday, 19th March 2017

                                 - Last call for finalist – 9.45am

Men (10 games)        - Sunday, 19th March 2017  
                                 - Check in time 2.00pm  
                                 - Last call for finalist - 2.15pm

### **Note:**

After the last call has been made (once) and where there are absentees, the reserves will be called. There will be no limit to the number of bowlers on the reserves list.

**March Oiling Pattern will be used in the Finals on 19th March 2017.**  
**The Esplanade Bowl's clock will be the official timepiece.**  
**It is the responsibility of Bowlers to check with the Bowling Counter Staff whether they are in the list of Finalists after the last qualifying squad on 17th March 2017.**

Each bowler will bowl 10 games in the finals. The bowler with the highest total pinfalls (with hcp) at the end of the competition will be declared the winner.

In the event of a tie in the finals and qualifying rounds, the bowler with the highest game (scratch scores) will be the winner. Should a further tie occur during the finals, the bowlers will share the prizes and the points allocated.

The standard Bowling Bye-Law for bowling attire will be applied throughout the competition.

The Esplanade Bowl House Awards will not apply during the qualifying rounds. However, the House Awards will apply for games bowled during the finals.

## Bowler of the year.

8 Ladies and 12 Men with the highest number of points accumulated from the three Medals Competitions, and who have bowled in **at least one final** will be invited to bowl in The Bowler of The Year Final on 12<sup>th</sup> November 2017.

## Singapore National Competition.

One Lady and one Man with the highest number of points accumulated from the three Medal competitions will be invited to represent SRC for the National Championship in November 2017.

## Points and Prizes

Points and prizes will be awarded to the top qualifiers and winners of each of the Medal Competitions as indicated:
