



# MIXED KNOCKOUT BOWL COMPETITION W/HANDICAP

This is a mixed event and is open to all SRC members of age 18 and above, born in 1999 and before. The format of the competition is the normal tenpin bowling game with handicap. The handicap is based on the established club averages for games bowled from 1st January 2016 to 30th June 2017.

Bowlers without a minimum number of 18 games will be deemed to be without an established average and will be given an assumed average of 175 for Ladies and 185 for Men. They will use the handicap of **16** for Ladies and **10** for Men. The maximum handicap for this event is **45**. (Please refer to the Handicap List at the notice board, computed on the formula :  $\frac{2}{3} \times (200 - \text{Average})$ ).

Bowlers in the current 2016/2017 National & National Development Squads will bowl with a Handicap of minus (-10) for Men and minus (-5) for Ladies.

The qualifying period for the competition will be from 3rd August to 22nd September 2017. Last squad for daily qualifying is at 10.15 pm. The last squad for this competition will be at 7.00 pm on Friday, 22nd September 2017. Bowlers will bowl a series of 3 games (with handicap) during the qualifying rounds. There is no limit to the number of attempts a bowler can make. After each attempt, the bowler will have to give way to the next batch of bowlers on the waiting list. **No lanes will be reserved at all times for this event during the qualifying period, Bowlers are advised to pre-book their qualifying slots with the Bowling counter.**

Bowlers can also attempt to qualify for the Event Finals during the Monday Mixed League and Saturday Single Mixed League. Bowlers will have to inform the Bowling Counter staff of their intention to do so before the league commences and will be charged a **trophy fund of \$11.77 (incl GST)**.

The top **40** bowlers will qualify to bowl in the Finals on 23rd September 2017.

## **FORMAT OF PLAY DURING THE FINALS**

### **Roll-Off**

40 bowlers will bowl 5 games in this roll-off. The top 16 bowlers with the highest pinfalls with handicap will advance to the Round of 16.

It is a knockout system from now on. Your opponent and lane will be decided by a “lane/bowler” draw before the commencement of each stage of the competition.

### **Round of 16**

16 Bowlers will bowl 1 (one) game each against an opponent in the Round of 16. The 8 winners will advance to the Quarter Finals.

### **Quarter Finals**

8 Bowlers will bowl 1 (one) game each against an opponent in the Quarter Finals. The 4 winners will advance to the Semi Finals.

### **Semi Finals**

4 Bowlers will bowl 1 (one) game each against an opponent in the Semi Finals. The last 2 surviving bowlers will advance to the Finals.

### **Finals**

The 2 finalists will bowl 1 KNOCKOUT game against each other. The winner will be declared the 2017 SRC Knockout Bowl Champion.

### **TIE**

In the event of a tie during qualifying and the final day roll-off, the highest game bowled (with handicap) will be the decider. If it is a further tie then the next highest score will be considered until the tie is broken.

In the event of a tie in the knockout stages, a toss of the coin will decide the bowler going through to the next round.

If there is a tie in the Grand Finale, a roll-off of frames 9-10 will be played. If the tie still exists, another roll-off of frames 9-10 will be played until the tie is broken.

### **ATTIRE And HOUSE AWARDS.**

The standard Bowling Bye-Law for bowling attire will be applied throughout the competition. The Esplanade Bowl House Awards will not apply during the qualifying rounds, however, it will apply for games bowled during the Finals.
