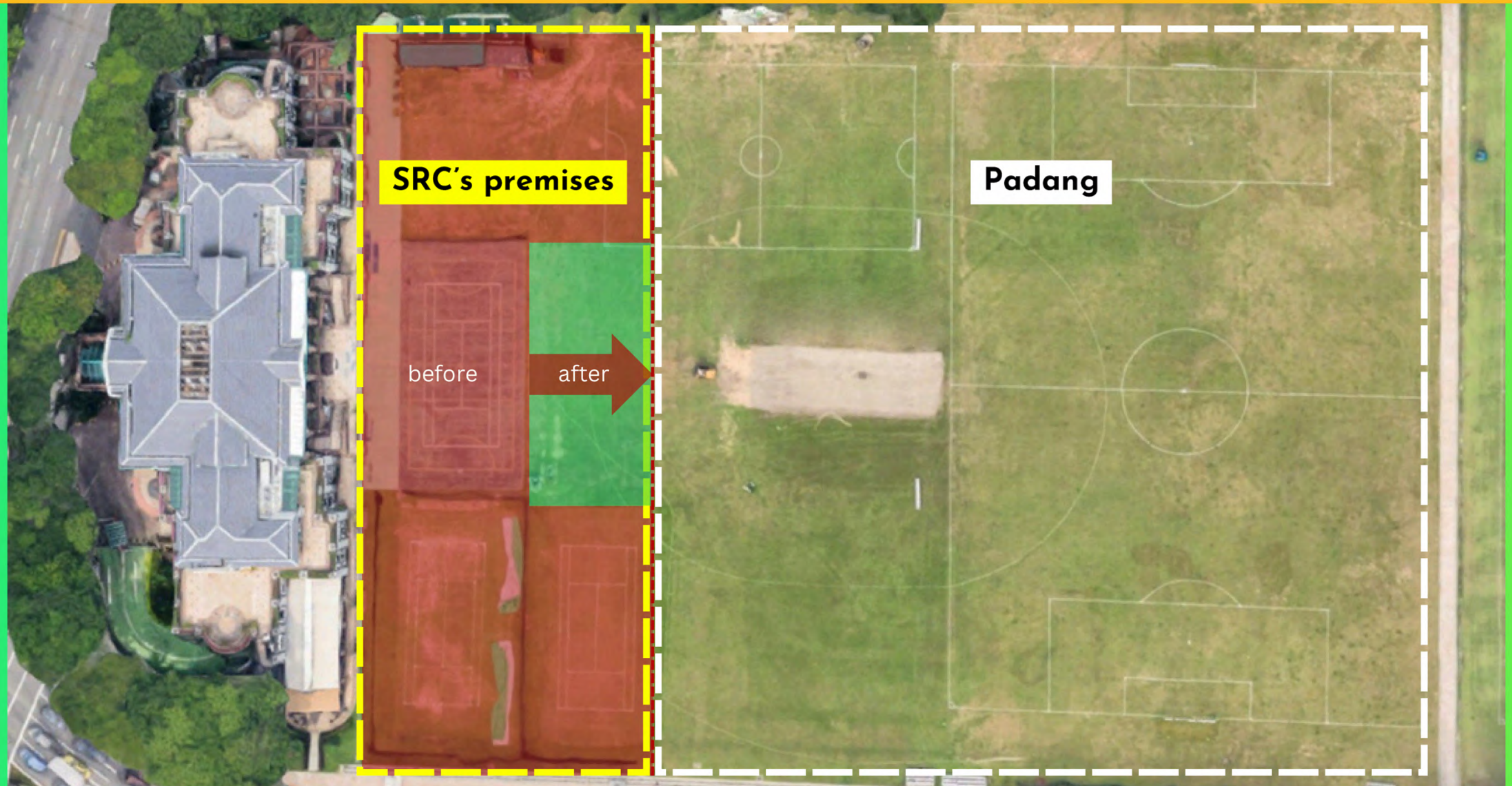

Recognizing the constraints faced during major national events like NDP and F1, where limited spaces and playing time hinder member activities for over seven months, we have set out to make a change. Thanks to reinstatement fees from external parties leasing our premises, we are initiating these reinstatements and enhancements without tapping into our reserves. Upon completion, members can anticipate not just one, but two tennis courts, two multipurpose courts, and a revamped multipurpose pitch available throughout the year. We are also addressing the challenges of afternoon sun glare and enhancing night lighting. Like all our members, we love and cherish the Padang, Singapore's 75th National Monument, and we are determined to keep it in tip-top condition. To achieve this, all the above-mentioned works are carried out at the SRC's premises. As part of our commitment, we are also actively working to enhance the Padang. The final touch includes an upgrade to the Padang's drainage system to prevent ponding, and we are re-turfing it with Zoysia grass for improved durability, playability, and aesthetic appeal.

THE OVERVIEW



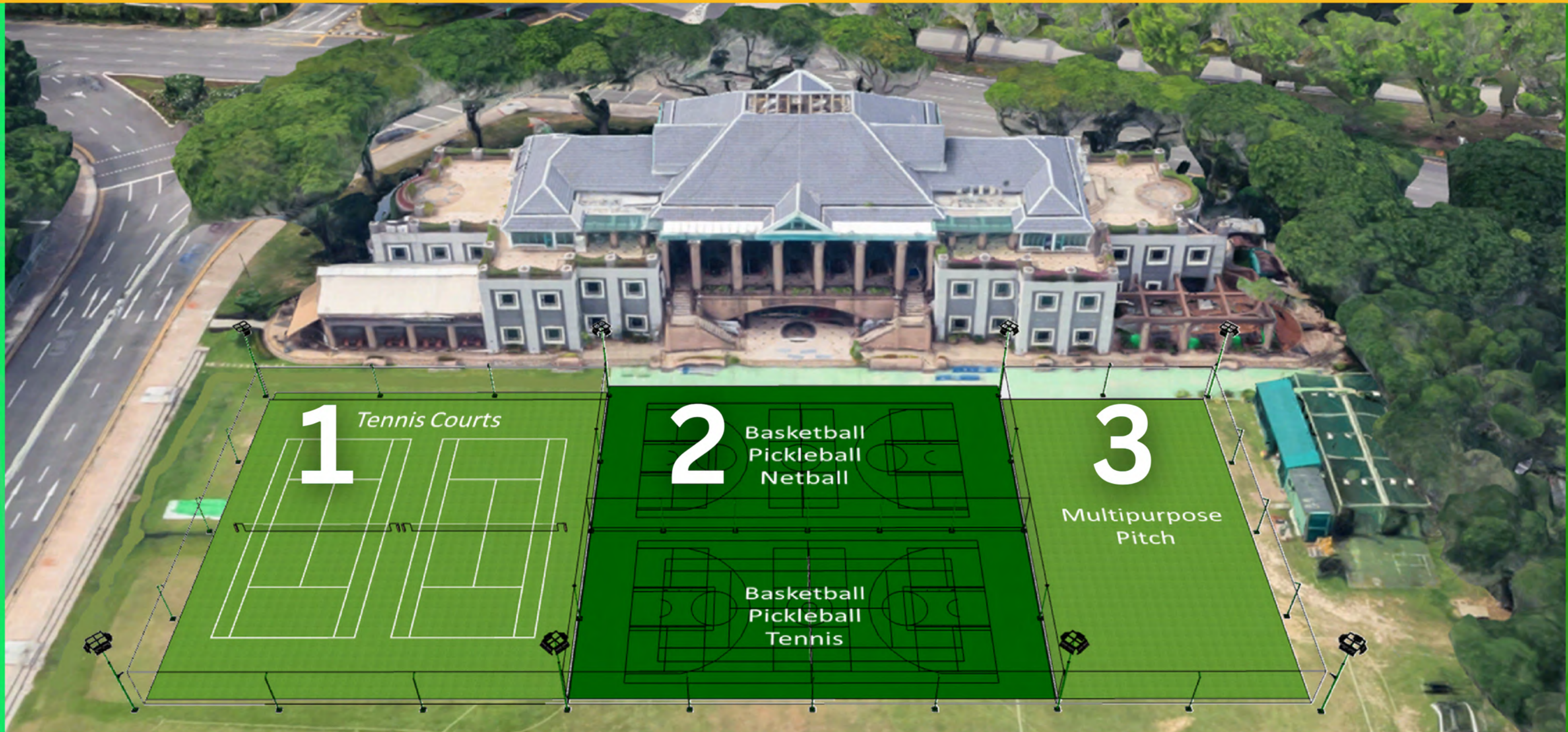
BEFORE

- smaller defined area for SRC
- during major events like NDP and F1, the club only has 1 multi-purpose court and 1 tennis court
- **7 months** of limited usage (Apr to Oct) during major national events every year

AFTER

- bigger defined area for SRC
- enhanced usage for members throughout the year
- during major national events, the club has minimally 2 tennis courts, 2 multi-purpose courts and 1 multi-purpose pitch for members' usage

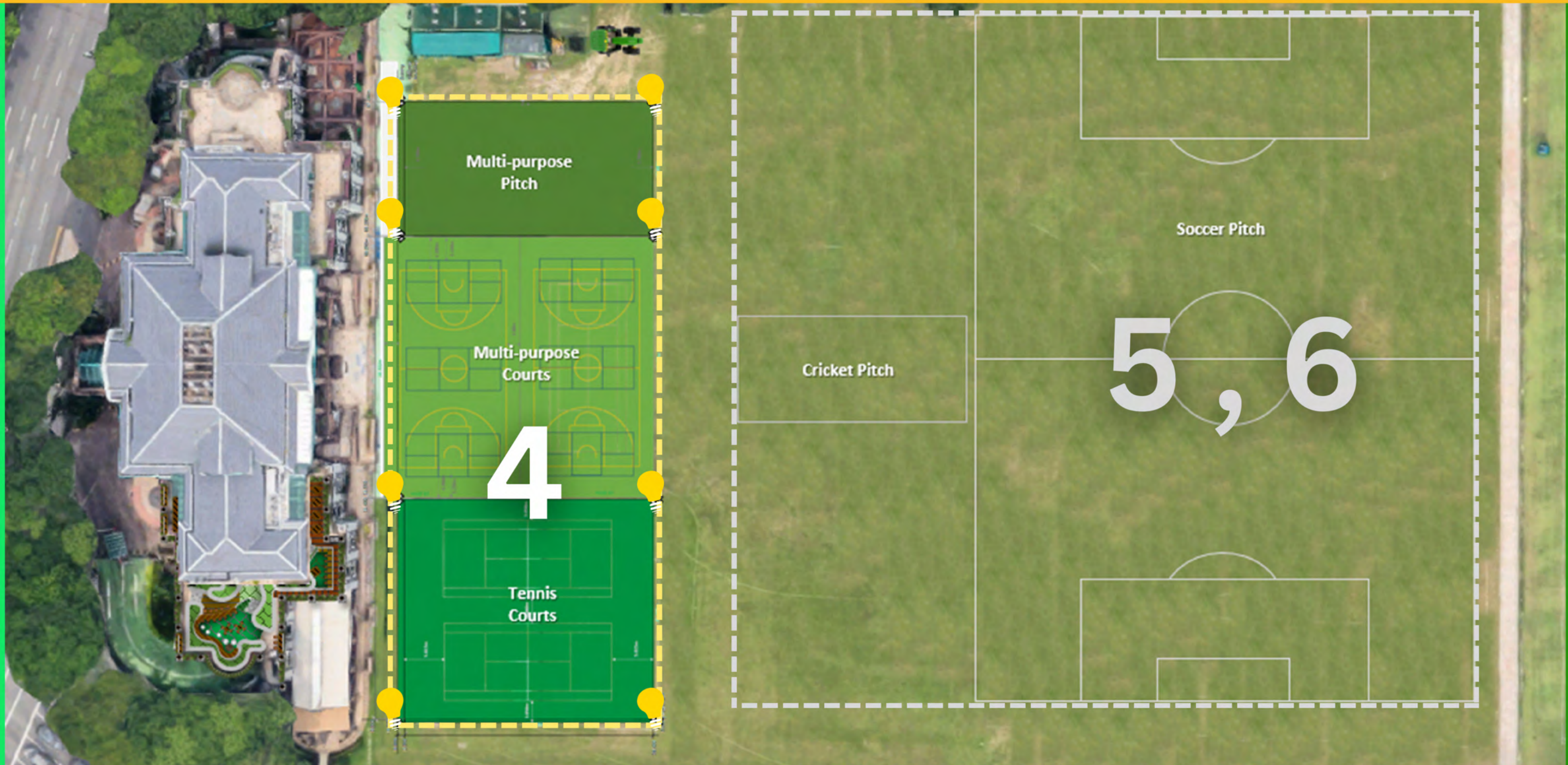
Re-orientation of artificial turf tennis court to avoid afternoon sun glare

Upgraded multi-purpose court to increase and diversify the range of sporting activities

Enhanced artificial turf multi-purpose pitch to achieve space optimisation for outdoor games and activities

Installation of high mast LED illumination to extend playing hours into late nights

Re-turfing of the Padang with Zoysia grass to enhance field durability and appearance

Improved drainage system of the Padang to increase the field's playability by preventing ponding and muddy conditions after rainfall
