



Legal Claim Filed Against the Club and 127th Management Committee

The Singapore Recreation Club (SRC) Management Committee (MC) is formally notifying all members regarding a legal action recently initiated against the Club and the 127th MC (“HC/OC 968/2025”).

The Club was served with a claim filed on 19 November 2025 at the Supreme Court by members Mr. Sean Kerwin Mathews and Mr. Mu Yee Shyong (the "Claimants").

The Claimants allege that Resolution 1a—to proceed with the addition and alteration works on level 2 of the clubhouse (Plan 1)—was invalidly passed at the Extraordinary General Meeting (EOGM) held on October 18, 2025.

The core reliefs sought by the Claimants includes:

- A declaration that Resolution 1a is invalid.
- An injunction to halt the implementation of Resolution 1a.
- An order for the individual 127th MC members (Defendants) to jointly and severally indemnify the Club for all resulting costs and expenses incurred.



Management Committee Position

The Management Committee firmly believes that the EOGM was conducted, and that Resolution 1a was properly passed and implemented, in compliance with the Club's Constitution. We are taking the necessary steps to robustly defend the Club and the actions of the MC in this matter. We will keep members updated on the progress of this matter as appropriate and in accordance with legal advice.

Status of Transformation Works

Pending the outcome of the court proceedings, the Management Committee will proceed with the implementation of Resolution 1a as mandated by the members.
