



Notice to Members: Registry of Societies' Review of Proposed Amendment to Rule 8 (Sporting Membership)

Dear Members,

The Management Committee wishes to inform Members of an administrative revision requested by the Registry of Societies ("ROS") following its review of the Club's Amendment of Rules application.

At the Club's 2026 Annual General Meeting, Members approved a resolution to amend Rule 8 (Rights & Privileges of Sporting Members) by removing the existing minimum age requirement of twelve (12) years for Sporting Membership, with the intention of providing the Club greater flexibility in developing and nurturing young sporting talent.

Following ROS's review of the proposed amendment, ROS advised that a society's constitution must clearly specify the eligibility criteria for membership, including the applicable minimum age. ROS therefore required that the proposed amendment specify a minimum age for Sporting Membership.

The revised wording requested by ROS is as follows:

Rule 8 – Rights & Privileges of Sporting Members

This category of membership is open to individuals who are **6 years and above** and who represent the Club in competitive sports. They will enjoy restricted privileges which shall be determined by the Management Committee from time to time. They will not be entitled to vote at any meeting. Their Membership shall cease upon their ceasing to represent the Club in competitive sports. The Management Committee shall at its absolute discretion determine when the Sporting Member shall cease to be such a member.

This notice is issued to keep Members informed of ROS's requirement and the proposed revision arising from the Club's Amendment of Rules application.
